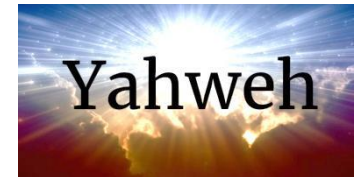
LIVING OUT THE PSALMS TODAY
