Four Marks of One Who Joyfully Perseveres in Times of Trouble

Psalm 63 (Living Out The Psalms)

1. Passionate Craving for God's Glory (1-2)

O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

2 So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.

2. Perfectly Content with God's Loving Kindness (3-5)

3 Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.

4 So I will bless you as long as I live; in your name I will lift up my hands.

5 My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips,

3. Persistent Concentration on the Faithfulness of God (6-8)

6 when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night;

7 for you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy.

8 My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.

4. Prevailing Confidence in the Sovereignty of God (9-11)

9 But those who seek to destroy my life shall go down into the depths of the earth;

10 they shall be given over to the power of the sword; they shall be a portion for jackals.

11 But the king shall rejoice in God; all who swear by him shall exult, for the mouths of liars will be stopped.



The earliest and longest lasting relationship that most everyone makes after entering this world is with their mother. It is a unique and intimate relationship that often shapes how you view, process and experience the world around you. Women are the vessels that God ordained to bring life into this world, and yet a mother is so much more than that initial act: being a mother is a choice and an action.
