*6 I will sing to the Lord,*

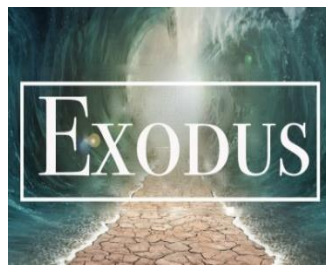

## THE CHURCH'S RESILIENCY
