No rounds by the doctors have been made yet, but she is hoping that someone will physically see his condition today so he may be given relief because he is in pain. His pain last Sunday was 10/10, and this morning was 9/10. He is able to eat, but he is in pain. Reports are given by the caregiver, praise God for providing them with efficient help. The caregiver's name is Ruth Macahilas. Kindly pray for protection for her, too. Doc Rochelle's dad is being referred to a hematologist because of the hematomas that appeared in his left arm. Treatment for CoVid has not started because creatinine is above normal. This is also a big prayer item. This needs to lower so that treatment can start. She prays that his dad will be relieved of pain and be comfortable. She and her sister, Christine (who is in the U.S.) also feel sad because they are not able to personally provide care for him. However, praise God for technology, they are able to do video calls everyday and able to share responsibility in deciding for their dad. Doc Rochelle is at home caring for her niece. Her niece, Raizel, though with COVid, too, is doing better. Please continue to pray for her full recovery as well. Also pray for Doc Rochelle and Christine as they monitor their father. Pray for peace of mind, sustained strength, and good health. There is good news on one test result of Doc Rochelle's dad - he had no stroke. It was suspected that he had one because of his lack of mobility and overall weakness. Doc Rochelle and her sister Christine, extends her gratefulness to everybody for praying with her for her father and niece.

- From Sis Gigi Edu on Doc Rochelle's dad: She was just able to talk to the doctor today. Creatinine level did not lower as hoped, but increased from 185 to 280 instead. They are thinking of quickening treatment due to Covid and to standby for dialysis. There is consideration to transfer hospitals because immediate management is not able to be done due to a lack of nursing care, patient and doctor interfacing. Please pray for wisdom for Doc Rochelle and sister, Christine, in making the decision about this and also for provision since Doc Rochelle's dad has no health card anymore. It has been cut off after he turned 75.

 Covid fee is different from a regular patient.
 - He is for referral to hematologist due to the hematoma. Salamat po sa pagiging katuwang sa pananalangin!
- From Sis Gigi Edu on Doc Rochelle's dad: She has been trying to call her dad's doctor at Medical City since yesterday, but it has been difficult to contact them. Praise God that she managed to contact the cardiologist today. However, since he is also a senior citizen, he will not be able to see his patient. He recommends that if there is a vacant slot, they should arrange for her dad to be transferred to a Covid care unit. Please pray for a slot to open for Doc Rochelle's dad to be transferred to this tertiary hospital. Please pray that he will not be refused admission, but that he will be placed in Covid care unit. In the present hospital, the doctor visited him only after 3 days. The doctor has suggested ICU care and dialysis, but Doc Rochelle and her sister, Christine, hope these will not be the case. They wish to transfer their dad so that he will receive better hospital care, will be closely monitored, and be given immediate treatment, too. Please pray for proper and smooth coordination between hospitals once a slot opens. Thank you po.
